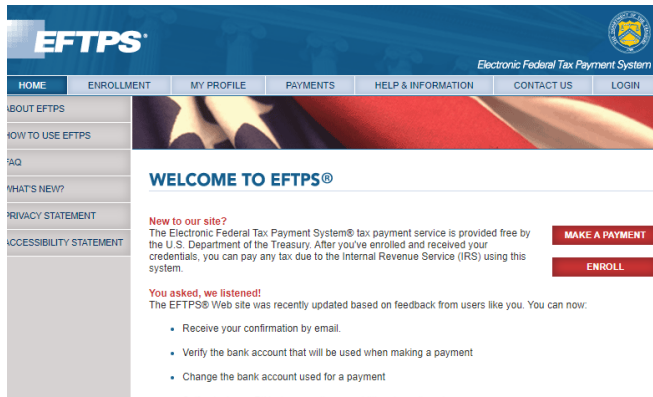
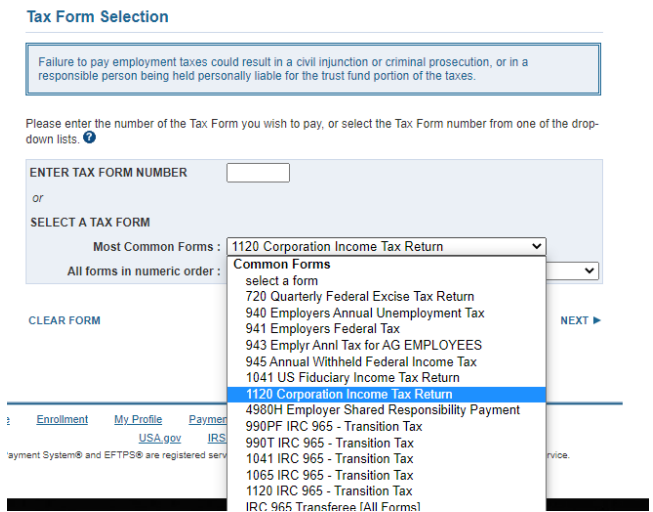


How to make online Federal ESTIMATED tax payments on EFTPS

1. Click make a payment and log into your EFTPS account (<https://www.eftps.gov/eftps/>)



2. "Select a Tax Form", Most common form: 1120 Corporation Income Tax Return



3. Select a Tax Type: Federal Tax Deposit



4. Enter in business tax payment

Pay amount- \$ amount for Federal estimated tax per instruction letter

Tax period-

Estimated tax payment will be paid towards **next year's tax return**

Example: Next year tax return has a year end of fiscal year end 3/31/22

Tax Period will be 2022 (even though payments are for your 2021 tax return)

Settlement Date- Date your payment will be complete and funds will be deducted from your account

Account- Verify checking account is correct
